### Lane Closures on State Route 86 and I Street In Brawley Postponed to New Year

EL CENTRO, Calif.—Caltrans reported that lane closures at the intersection of I Street and State Route 86 (SR-86)/Main Street have been postponed to after New Year’s Day because of construction material delays.

Lane closures on SR-86 just west of Brawley from the New River Bridge to Brandt Road will also be postponed.

Notice will be given once the materials become available and the work can be rescheduled.

The work part of a Caltrans pavement repair project addressing 32 lane miles of SR-86 from I Street to Brandt Road near Brawley, and from just east of B Street to Martin Road in Westmorland.

The \$5.3 million project to repair and repave portions of SR-86 funded from Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, will help provide a safer and smoother commute for motorists. The improvements are expected to be completed in January.

The work schedule is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and other construction-related issues. SB 1 provides an ongoing funding increase of approximately \$1.8 billion annually for the maintenance and rehabilitation of the state highway system. SB 1 funds will enable Caltrans to fix more than 17,000 lane miles of pavement, 500 bridges and 55,000 culverts by 2027.
