NOTICE AND INVITATION TO BIDDERS
SOUTHWEST BRAWLEY STREET MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE II

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids for the **SOUTHWEST BRAWLEY STREET MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE II** will be received by the City of Brawley (City) in the offices of the Public Works Department 180 South Western Avenue, Brawley, California 92227 until **2:00 P.M. Local Time, on January 13, 2026**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. No late bids will be accepted.

The Contract for the work advertised will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The City reserves the right to reject all bids, waive any irregularities, or dispense with further bidding.

BID BOND: Shall be completed in the forms provided as per Instructions to Bidders and accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or a Bid Bond executed in favor of the City of Brawley in an amount of ten percent of the bid to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment and performance bonds, both equal to 100% of the contract amount.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: Liquidated Damages of \$1,750.00 per calendar day are included in this project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

It is intended that the work be completed in every respect under the Contract, and such items or details not mentioned above that are required by the Contract documents shall be furnished, performed, placed, constructed, or installed by the Contractor. The work includes slurry seal coating, crack sealing, SS-1H fog sealing, and pavement striping. Proposals shall conform to the requirements of this Invitation for Proposals and other documents listed herein and any addenda issued before the proposal opening date.

The specifications setting forth requirements and the work to be performed is comprised of the following:

COMPLETION OF WORK: The work must be completed within **90** calendar days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed.

CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: The contractor shall have a State of California Classification "A" Contractor's license to perform the work. A bid submitted by any contractor not properly licensed at the time of bid opening shall be considered non-responsive and will be rejected.

MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING: A **Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting** will be held to familiarize all interested bidders with the conditions of the project and the project site. The meeting will convene at **10:00 a.m., at the City of Brawley Public Works Department, 180 Western Avenue, Brawley, CA on January 7, 2026**, with a walkthrough of the project site after the meeting.

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS-REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT FOR AWARD: No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations according to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

STATE PREVAILING WAGE RATES: Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the State of California Department of Industrial Relations, is set forth in the Instruction for Bidders section of the specifications.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations.

APPRENTICES: Attention is directed to the provisions of Sections 1777.5 and 1777.6 of the Labor Code Concerning the employment of apprentices by the Contractor or any subcontractor under him. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to ensure that all persons shall comply with the requirements of said sections in the employment of apprentices.

RETENTION: The city will retain a portion of the Contract price as required by law. The Contractor may substitute securities in place of the retained funds withheld by the City. Alternatively, an escrow agreement, in the form prescribed under Ca. Public Contract Code 22300, may be used by the Contractor.

BIDDING DOCUMENTS: Bidding documents may be requested from the City of Brawley Public Works Department via email at vleon@brawley-ca.gov, Monday through Friday from 8 am – 12 pm and 1 pm – 5 pm (closed from 12 pm – 1 pm). Only those firms that have obtained bid documents from the City will be directly provided with any addendums that may be issued for this project before the bid opening date. If you are requesting bid documents from the plan rooms, you will need to check with the plan rooms for a copy or follow up with the City to obtain a copy.
