AB 2561 requires public agencies, including the City of Brawley to hold at least one (1) public hearing per fiscal year to discuss vacancies and recruitment and retention efforts. This report discusses the City's legal obligations under the new law, which took effect January 1, 2025. This report recommends the adoption of measures intended to ensure compliance with such legal obligations.

Background:

AB 2561 was introduced to address the issue of job vacancies in local government, which adversely affects the delivery of public services and employee workload. Among other requirements, the bill mandates that public agencies present the status of vacancies and recruitment and retention efforts during a public hearing before the agency's governing body at least once per fiscal year. The bill was enacted into law and is codified at Government Code section 3502.3. The new law is effective January 1, 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no direct fiscal impact associated with conducting the public hearing required under Government Code section 3205.3. However, addressing recruitment and retention issues may involve future budget and bargaining considerations, which will be presented to the City Council as necessary.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. Approve the Recommendation: Adopt City Council Policy No. 153-65 and the Procedures for the Public Hearing on City Vacancies and Recruitment and Retention Efforts.
- 2. Modify the Recommendation: Adjust City Council Policy No. 153-65 or the Procedures for the Public Hearing on City Vacancies and Recruitment and Retention Efforts.
- 3. Decline the Recommendation: Reject City Council Policy No. 153-65 and Procedures for the Public Hearing on City Vacancies and Recruitment and Retention Efforts, which may result in non-compliance with Government Code section 3502.3 and could have legal and operational repercussions for the City.

Policy Number: 153 - 65

Purpose:

This policy establishes the framework and requirements for holding public hearings and reporting on the City's workforce vacancies, recruitment, and retention efforts, in compliance with Assembly Bill (AB) 2561 (Gov. Code § 3502.3). The purpose is to ensure transparency, accountability, and responsiveness to community needs regarding the City's staffing and employment practices.

Scope

This policy applies to the City Council of the City of Brawley.

Definitions

- **Public Hearing:** A formal meeting that is open to the public, where City of Brawley representatives present information and accept public comments on specific topics, as required by law.
- **Vacancies:** Unfilled positions within the City of Brawley's workforce that require recruitment efforts to be adequately staffed.
- **Recruitment:** The process of attracting, screening, and selecting qualified candidates for employment with the City of Brawley.
- **Retention:** Efforts to maintain a stable and satisfied workforce by addressing the factors that contribute to workforce stability.

Policy Statement

In accordance with AB 2561 (Gov. Code § 3502.3), the City Council is committed to:

- Holding public hearings on workforce vacancies, recruitment, and retention.
- Addressing any issues in current policies, procedures, or recruitment activities that may hinder hiring efforts.
- Ensuring transparency and public participation in discussions around staffing challenges and solutions.

Public hearings shall be held at least once per fiscal year, with accompanying reports on the status of vacancies, recruitment efforts, and retention initiatives.

Policy Provisions

1. Public Hearing Requirements

- The City Council shall conduct public hearings at least annually (once per fiscal year).
- Hearings will present information on:
 - Workforce vacancies
 - Recruitment and retention efforts
 - o Issues in policies or procedures that may hinder hiring
- Public hearings must:
 - o Be announced in advance
 - Allow for public comment
 - Permit recognized employee organizations to present information, concerns, and recommendations
- Separate hearings may be scheduled for individual bargaining units or groupings.
- Each hearing shall be documented with minutes and a recording, to be made publicly available within **30 days** of the hearing.

2. Reporting Requirements

At each public hearing, the City Council shall present information on:

- 1. The current status of workforce vacancies.
- 2. Ongoing recruitment and retention efforts.
- 3. Identified obstacles within existing hiring-related policies and procedures.

If the City Council prepares a formal report with this information, it may be made available to the public via the City of Brawley website or in print prior to the hearing.

3. Special Reporting Requirements for High Vacancy Rates

If the vacancy rate within a single bargaining unit equals or exceeds 20% of the total authorized full-time positions, and upon request from a recognized employee organization, the City Council shall include in the hearing:

- 1. The total number of job vacancies within the affected bargaining unit.
- 2. The total number of applicants for those vacant positions.
- 3. The average number of days to complete the hiring process from the date of job posting.



PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING AB 2561 LOCAL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES VACANT POSITIONS

This is an internal document used by agency staff in conjunction with the governing body to develop procedures for the governing body to conduct and administer the public hearings required under Government Code section 3502.3.

Introduction and Scope:

Effective January 1, 2025, Government Code section 3502.3 requires **City of Brawley** to present information on the status of vacancies at the City and the City's recruitment and retention efforts at a public hearing before the City of Brawley's City Council at least once per fiscal year.

Government Code section 3502.3 also requires the **City of Brawley** to identify during the public hearing any necessary changes to City policies, procedures, and recruitment activities that may contribute to obstacles in the City's hiring process.

At the public hearing, a recognized employee organization for a bargaining unit is entitled to make a presentation to the **City of Brawley's City Council** addressing the status of vacancies and recruitment and retention efforts for positions within that bargaining unit.

The purpose of these procedures is to establish protocol for the **City of Brawley's** public hearings on vacancies in order to ensure a fair, orderly and efficient hearing process.

The agency should reserve the right to schedule separate public hearings for different bargaining units, and it is not limited to one public hearing to address all vacancies and recruitment and retention efforts within the entire agency.

Notice Requirements:

1. The City will notify in writing each recognized employee organization that represents City employees that the City of Brawley's City Council will hold a hearing pursuant to the obligations set forth under Government Code section 3502.3 (Assembly Bill 2561). The notice will provide each recognized employee organization the opportunity to identify any negotiable impacts/effects regarding the agency's compliance with Government Code section 3502.3 and the agency's board policy.



PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING AB 2561 LOCAL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES VACANT POSITIONS

2. The **City** will notify in writing each recognized employee organization that represents **City employees** of the date, time and place of the hearing at least **ten** (10) working days in advance of the hearing.

In the notice, the **City** will inquire whether the employee organization intends to make a presentation to the **City of Brawley**'s **City Council** at the public hearing. The **City** will request that, for planning purposes, the employee organization provides written notice to the Human Resources Department at least **five (5) working days** in advance of the public hearing indicating whether the employee organization intends to make a presentation at the public hearing.

The notice will also include information about the amount of time that the **City Council** has allotted to employee organizations for each bargaining unit that the organization represents for purpose of making a presentation at the public hearing.

- 3. In the event the vacancy rate for the bargaining unit is at least 20% of the total number of authorized full-time positions in the bargaining unit, an employee organization may request that the City present "additional information" related to the vacancies as permitted by Government Code section 3502.3. The City will request that the employee organization provide a written request for the presentation of such information to the Human Resources Department at least five (5) working days in advance of the public hearing. The "additional information" includes the following: (1) the total number of job vacancies within the bargaining unit; (2) the total number of applicants for vacant positions within the bargaining unit; (3) the average number of days to complete the hiring process from when a position is posted; and (4) opportunities to improve compensation and other working conditions.
- 4. Notice of the hearing to the public will be provided in accordance with the Ralph M. Brown Act. (Gov. Code §§ 54950-54963.)
- 5. A City staff report regarding vacancies, recruitment, and retention efforts may be published as part of the agenda packet for the meeting.
- 6. The City and recognized employee organizations may agree to exchange presentation materials in advance of the public hearing.

Order of the Hearing:



PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING AB 2561 LOCAL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES VACANT POSITIONS

The public hearing will proceed in the following order:

- 1. <u>City Presentation</u>: The City presentation will be limited to **ten (10) minutes** for each bargaining unit that it represents. The City may choose to present on all bargaining units at once, or to present data for each bargaining unit separately followed by each applicable employee organization presentation.
- 2. <u>Employee Organization Presentation</u>: Following the agency presentation, each employee organization will have the opportunity to make a presentation for each of the bargaining units that the employee organization represents. For each bargaining unit, the employee organization presentation will be limited to ten (10) minutes and should not contain bargaining proposals to the City on matters that have not been presented in bargaining.
- 3. **Governing Body Questions and Discussion**: The City of Brawley's City Council may ask questions of the City and the employee organization presenters.
- 4. <u>Final City Comments</u>: Final City comments will be limited to **three (3) minutes** per bargaining unit.
- 5. <u>Final Employee Organization Comments</u>: Final employee organization comments will be limited to **three (3) minutes** per bargaining unit.
- 6. **Public Comment**: Public comment regarding the AB 2561 hearing will be limited to **three (3)** minutes per person.

Standards of Discourse:
