SoCalGas to Begin Pipeline Inspection Project in Brawley Beginning on January 18

Crews are expected to work in the area through March 2019

WHAT: SoCalGas will be performing a safety inspection on a natural gas pipeline along Old Highway 111 and Best Avenue in the City of Brawley starting January 18. To perform the pipeline work safely, northbound lanes along Old Highway 111 and Best Avenue will be reduced during work hours. Traffic signs will be posted to help direct the flow of traffic.

No interruption to natural gas service is anticipated.

Customers may smell the odor of natural gas. Although this is normal when crews are working, SoCalGas encourages anyone who smells gas to call us at 1-800-427-2200. SoCalGas is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
